## **FOR THE ATTENTION OF PARENTS/GUARDIANS**

As part of the 'Inclusion Initiative' across the National Curriculum the Physical Education Faculty is continuing to implement the following Policy:

- All pupils will be expected to change for Physical Education.
- Those who have medical notes will also be expected to change into a tracksuit or other appropriate warm leisure clothing. They will then take on a coaching, refereeing/umpiring or choreography role within the lesson.
- Pupils will not be asked to physically take part, but their learning of tactics, strategies and rules will be developed as a direct result of them taking on a more 'hands on' involvement in their lessons.

Data from previous years indicates that this 'Inclusion Initiative' will help to improve your child's learning in Physical Education and provide them with a greater range of exit routes post Kingdown School.

Please could you assist the Physical Education Faculty by checking your child's organiser and ensuring that they have the correct kit when required.
